



The Austrian 101-year old Alfred Proksch won the gold medal in shot put

Austrian Alfred Proksch won gold medal in shot put in the age group 100+ at the World Master Athletic Championships in Lahti with a result 2,84m. In addition to the gold medal, he was awarded the golden badge of merit by Lahden Ahkera sport club. The badge was given by the president of Lahden Ahkera Mr. Vesa Harmaakorpi.

Alfred, who was 6th in Pole Vault at the 1936 Berlin Olympics, will continue his Championships on Monday, the 3th of August with discus. Alfred is very optimistic of this competition as well.
